Subject : 6C Computer

1. **Standard Form:**

You must be able to write your name, date and class in standard form.

2. **Acronyms:**

You must be able to write down the words that the letters stand for (i.e. RAM = Random Access Memory)

3. **Computer Parts:**

You must be able to identify the parts of a computer and explain what they do.

4. **Measurements:**

You must be able to explain what unit we use to measure how much information can be put on a computer and you need to know the different prefixes and how much they symbolize (i.e. 1 KB = 1024 bytes). You also need to be able to tell me roughly how many bytes are in megabytes, gigabytes, etc.

5. **Binary Numbers:**

You must be able to explain how binary numbers are used and why they are used in computing. You do **not** need to know how to convert decimal numbers to binary numbers.

6. **Licenses:**

You must be able to explain what copyright means and what the normal conditions of a proprietary license involve. You need to understand what the normal conditions of an open source license involve and why they are different from proprietary licenses.

7. **Touch Typing:**

You must be able to explain why we use the keyboard we use and what its name is. You also need to explain why we don't use the alternatives (and what the main alternative's name is). You need to also explain why we learn to touch type.
