Dear Parents

Greetings. I hope that you have had the opportunity to glance at the calendar that we have online at <http://www.lesbg.com>. Note that we will be posting all Latest News on that site so please look at it at least once per week.

I am really writing this letter to advise you of one of the most exciting events on the school calendar, the Ski Camp.

Every year the school runs a ski camp directly after the Mid Year Exams. Dates are as listed below.

| Day                                      | Details  |

| Tuesday 16 <sup>th</sup> February 2010   | Students leave school at between 2:00 pm and 4:00 pm. They drop all their stuff at Mount Smash and then go up to fit their boots and skis. |
| Wednesday 17 <sup>th</sup> February 2010 | Day 1 Skiing.  |
| Thursday 18 <sup>th</sup> February 2010  | Day 2 Skiing.  |
| Friday 19 <sup>th</sup> February 2010    | Day 3 Skiing.<br>Leave Mount Smash at 5:00 pm. In school by 6:00 pm.   |

This camp is for everyone. Children that can ski are very welcome but this camp is also very much for kids that would like to learn to ski. Free tuition will be available on Wednesday and Thursday morning from 8 am until 12 noon and then, in the afternoon, they will be able to practice what they have learnt in the morning. If they are real beginners then they might like to rest in the afternoon. The choice is theirs. There will be experienced skiing staff on the camp, able to help at all times of the day.

I strongly advise you to send your children on this camp. It is great fun and a very cheap way of learning to ski considering that the tuition is free. When I was young (many decades ago!!) I learnt to ski this way and thank my parents for the great opportunity that they gave me. Even with free tuition I realize that it is not cheap but skiing is one of the most wonderful sports that there is.

The cost of the Ski Camp is 180,000 LL (the same as last year). This includes accommodation, transport, meals, ski hire and tuition but NOT ski passes. These need to be bought every day on the slopes. Note that if you want to snowboard or ski with BigFoot skis then you will need to pay 5\$ per day more for the ski hire. The basic price only includes normal ski hire.

Lift Passes for the 2009 - 2010 season are priced as follows :

Please book as soon as you can as places are limited this year.

Once a booking is made a list of clothing that needs to be taken will be issued. Please note that there is no need to spend huge amounts of money on expensive ski clothes. Normal clothes with cheap waterproof coverings are quite sufficient. This will be explained clearly on the list.
