



Hair Length

Dear Parents of Junior and Infant Students,

This is a letter addressing the difficulties caused by students in the Junior Department with long hair and explains the school's policy towards long hair.

1. We feel it is IMPOSSIBLE for students to concentrate in class while hair is covering their eyes and/or the student is constantly having to touch their hair to try to keep it away from their eyes and face.
2. Because of the many activities students are involved in during breaks, and in class, students with long hair find it more difficult to participate and/or are more likely to become sweaty, which can often lead to creating bad odors and messy hair that Infant and Junior students cannot control even when their hair is tied back.

Therefore, for hygienic reasons, the school requires the following procedures be followed when dealing with students with long hair:

- ALL girls' hair should be tied back neatly, away from the face.
- ALL boys' hair should be cut short. Boys' hair should be above the eyebrow level at the front and at the neck level from the back.
- If you have a medical or a religious reason for your child to have long hair, please provide a letter of explanation from the specific association to the Administration OR a signed letter from Dr. White. Otherwise, long hair will not be tolerated.
- No hair highlights are allowed in the Infant and the Junior Departments.
- Students who have long hair for a medical or a religious reason should have it tied to the back AT ALL TIMES, or -2 will be deducted from their conduct each time.
